In 2009, C.A.T. - Chiropractic Action Team was founded in response to central Italy's devastating earthquake. As a result of the first ever contract of collaboration between Italy's national branch of the IFRC – the Croce Rossa Italiana CRI and the Italian national association of the World Federation of Chiropractic – WFC. Voluntary chiropractic treatments were donated as a support service to emergency workers in the camps of the earthquake zone.

For 2010, a second pilot project was approved by CRI's President Francesco Rocca for the creation of a CHIROPRACTIC "INFIRMARY" Clinic inside their Milan emergency center of Bresso, Italy. The office will be serviced a few hours weekly by local chiropractors on a volunteer basis. The aim is to facilitate the provision of on-site support by CAT chiropractors for Red Cross volunteers, staff and community members during emergency situations and in times of tranquility.

In 2010, CAT has grown to become a non – profit international humanitarian aid nongovernmental organization with membership limited to Doctors of Chiropractic with training in disaster relief who provide pro bono chiropractic services in collaboration with the Red Cross's disaster activities. CAT has entered collaborative talks with the American Red Cross's head of disaster partner services to develop a pilot project in the United States.

Our goal is to collaborate on a long term international level with the IFRC. We have made much success on the national level as seen with CRI and the ARC, but we now would like to present the idea globally so that we can participate in future disasters wherever we may be needed most. Now, it is important to work across agencies and organizations to develop and deliver a world class disaster response.
